In *Lemon Tree* Israel's defence minister has moved into house adjoining a lemon grove, the only source of income for the Palestinian widow who is his neighbour. The defence minister insists that the trees be cut down for security reasons. The widow fights back, all the way to the Israeli Supreme Court, provoking the sympathies of the Israeli minister's wife. The film reveals a deep commonality between the two women, both victimized by patriarchal attitudes toward war and women. This film received many award nominations at the European Film Festival.
