**Peter Woods'** main love is jazz, but he also enjoys making music with colleagues steeped in rock and blues and folk and classical genres. He has provided musical leadership for numerous jazz liturgies, events during the Ottawa International Jazz Festival and the Montreal International Jazz Festival, as well as various gatherings of the United, Presbyterian, and Anglican Churches across Canada.

Montreal-born pianist **Brian Browne** is regarded as one of the leading proponents of jazz piano in Canada. Browne's distinctive, bluesy piano style swings with traces of Art Tatum, Oscar Peterson, Errol Garner and Bill Evans, yet the sound is unmistakably his own. Brian's recordings: Blue Browne, Tramps, Beatles, Live at the Park Plaza, The Letter, Quiet Night, and Odyssey, are now all available on CD.
